

Terms of Service

Omniscient Labs Website and Services

1. Acceptance of Terms

These Terms of Service ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the website, online services, products, applications, content, communications, and related offerings provided by Omniscient Labs ("Omniscient Labs," "we," "us," or "our") that link to or reference these Terms (collectively, the "Services").

By accessing or using the Services, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you use the Services on behalf of an organization, you represent that you have authority to bind that organization, and "you" includes that organization. If you do not agree to these Terms, do not use the Services.

2. Eligibility and Accounts

5. User Content

You may be able to submit, upload, transmit, or otherwise provide content, data, text, images, files, prompts, feedback, or other materials to the Services ("User Content"). You retain ownership of your User Content, subject to the rights granted in these Terms.

You grant Omniscient Labs a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to host, store, reproduce, process, transmit, display, adapt, and use User Content as needed to provide, maintain, secure, support, and improve the Services, comply with law, and enforce these Terms. This license ends when your User Content is deleted from our systems, except to the extent retention is needed for legal, security, backup, or legitimate business purposes.

You represent that you have all rights, permissions, and authority necessary to provide User Content and to grant the license above. You are responsible for your User Content and for ensuring that it does not violate law, third-party rights, or these Terms.

6. Ownership and Intellectual Property

The Services, including software, designs, text, graphics, logos, interfaces, features, documentation, and other materials, are owned by Omniscient Labs or its licensors and are protected by intellectual property and other laws. Except for rights expressly granted in these Terms, no rights are granted to you by implication or otherwise.

13. Disclaimers

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Services are provided "as is" and "as available" without warranties of any kind, whether express, implied, statutory, or otherwise. Omniscient Labs disclaims all warranties, including warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, non-infringement, availability, accuracy, reliability, security, and error-free operation.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Omniscient Labs and its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents, licensors, and service providers from and against any claims, liabilities, damages, losses, and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, arising out of or related to your use of the Services, User Content, violation of these Terms, violation of law, or infringement of rights of another person or entity.

16. Governing Law and Disputes

These Terms are governed by the laws applicable in the jurisdiction where Omniscient Labs is organized, without regard to conflict of law rules, unless applicable law requires otherwise. You and Omniscient Labs agree to attempt to resolve disputes informally before starting formal proceedings.

If a dispute cannot be resolved informally, the courts or other dispute-resolution forum with proper jurisdiction over Omniscient Labs' principal place of business will have authority to resolve the dispute, unless applicable law requires a different forum.

17. General Terms

These Terms, together with any additional terms that apply to specific Services, constitute the entire agreement between you and Omniscient Labs regarding the Services. If any provision is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in effect. Our failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver of our right to do so later.
